Heather has worked extensively in community college ESL programs in the Baltimore area and was previously an English Language Fellow, a job which took her to Panama and Indonesia as an EFL teacher and teacher-trainer. Her research interests include standards for TESOL teacher education programs, advocacy for English language learners, and the uses of technology, specifically digital storytelling, within ESL/EFL classes.
